BMP is usually inspected once every 10 years A trained evaluator will assess the BMP Determine if the BMP is providing the pollutant removal

Identify if the BMP needs major restoration

Inspector evaluates the BMP

The BMP passes inspection

The community records the inspection result

once every 10 years

BMP is usually inspected

Include date of the inspection

Pass along to the state regulatory agency and the Chesapeake Bay

Inspector evaluates the BMP

The BMP fails inspection

Has one year to take corrective action

A forensic BMP investigation is conducted

The community records the inspection result

Log in BMP inventory system The community begins to identify how to remediate the problem
