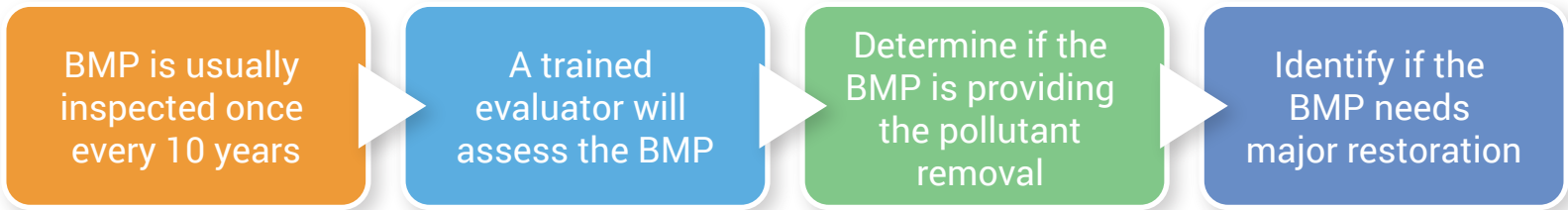


BMP Inspection Process



- 1 Inspector evaluates the BMP
- 2 The BMP passes inspection
- 3 The community records the inspection result

- BMP is usually inspected once every 10 years
- Include date of the inspection
- Pass along to the state regulatory agency and the Chesapeake Bay

- 1 Inspector evaluates the BMP
- 2 The BMP fails inspection
- 3 A forensic BMP investigation is conducted
- 4 The community records the inspection result
- 5 The community begins to identify how to remediate the problem

Has one year to take corrective action
